1.0 DEFINITION

In this licence, unless stated otherwise or the context otherwise requires:-

- 1.1.1 "Acts" means the Tanzania Communications Regulatory Authority Act No.12 of 2003, Broadcasting Services Act No.6 of 1993 and the Tanzania Communications Act No.18 of 1993.
- 1.1.2 "Authority" means the Tanzania Communications Regulatory Authority
- 1.1.3 "Licence" means authority to provide Content Services
- 1.1.4 "Licensee" means any person holding Content Services licence
- 1.1.5 "Minister" means the Minister responsible for Broadcasting
- 1.1.6 **"Content Services"** means service offered for sound, data, text or images whether still or moving except where transmitted on private communication
- 1.1.7 "Effective Date" means the date of issuance of this licence
- 1.1.8 **"Licence Period"** means the period authorises holder of this licence to provide content services.
- 1.1.9 **"Construction Permit"** means the authorization to begin construction of facilities for the provision of content services.
- 1.1.10 "Services Areas" means the licenced area covered by the footprint of the service offered.

2.0 SCOPE OF THE LICENCE

2.3	NAME AND STATION IDENTIFICATION							
2.3.1	The Licensee's station identification is							
2.3.2	The Licensee shall not change its station identification without having obtained the Authority's prior written consent, which consent shall not be withheld unreasonably and upon payment of fees for the change of the name and station identification.							
2.3.3	The Licensee must clearly identify itself by its station identification regularly every hour during the broadcasting period when it provides content to the public.							
3.0	DURATION AND RENEWAL OF THE LICENCE							
3.1.	This licence is granted on							
3.2.	The Authority shall renew the licence period in accordance with the Tanzania Communications Regulatory Authority Act, 2003 and the Tanzania Broadcasting Services Act No 6 of 1993.							
3.3	Prior to the expiry of the Licence, the Licensee shall be entitled to apply to the Authority for the renewal of this licence in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Acts, but shall not have any right to, or expectation of, such renewal.							
3.4	The Licence terminates upon expiry of the licence period if not renewed.							
3.5	The licensee shall submit an application for renewal six months before the expiry date.							
4.0	LICENCE FEES							
4.1	The Licence Fees in respect of this Licence and its renewal shall be determined by the Authority.							
4.2	In addition to any licence application fee paid by the Licensee, the Licensee shall pay to the Authority:

The Royalty fees shall be paid quarterly on every following month after the quarter. Any Royalty fee delayed for more than thirty (30) days shall

attract Penalty at prevailing official Bank lending rate.

The Licensee shall comply with the provisions of the Regulations and Rules issued by the Authority under the Acts.

7.0. COMPLIANCE WITH SPECTRUM PLAN

The Licensee shall comply with the spectrum plan issued by Authority under the Acts.

8.0. <u>COMPLIANCE WITH CONSUMER CODES</u>

The Licensee shall comply with any consumer codes registered under the Acts which are relevant to the activities of the Licensee.

9.0 PROVISION OF CONTENT SERVICES

The Licensee shall provide services in accordance with the applicable Content Regulations, 2005 and Programme codes.

10.0 PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE

- 10.1 The Licensee shall guarantee performance of the terms and conditions of the licence and shall execute a guarantee in favour of the Authority subject to performance bank guarantee/performance bond requirement under the Licensing Regulations, 2005.
- 10.2 A Performance Bank Guarantee/Performance Bond of Us \$being 10 % of the investment cost for the licence category, valid for one year from Bank in the prescribed form shall be submitted to the Authority
