THE ELECTRONIC POSTAL COMMUNICATIONS ACT, (CAP. 306)

REGULATIONS

(Made under section 165)

THE ELECTRONIC AND POSTAL COMMUNICATIONS (LICENSING) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2025

Citation

GN. No. 57 of 2018

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Electronic and Postal Communications (Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations, 2025 and shall be read as one with the Electronic and Postal Communications (Licensing) Regulations, 2018 hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations".

Amendment of regulation 2

- **2.** The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 2 by-
 - (a) deleting paragraphs (i) and (j) and substituting for them the following:
 - "(i) cyber security service licences;
 - (i) online media service licences;".

Amendment of regulation 3

- 3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 3 by-
 - (a) adding in its appropriate alphabetical order the following new definitions:

""call centre" means a centralised facility
that is equipped to handle a large
volume of telecommunication calls
and SMS and other related services
for the purpose of providing services
to the customers, technical support
and other related services;

"cybersecurity services" means cybersecurity consultancy services

- including penetration testing or managing security operation centres and any other cybersecurity related services:
- "earth station" means a station located either on the earth's surface or within the major portion of the earth's atmosphere and intended for communication with-
 - (i) one or more space stations, or
 - (ii) one or more stations of the same kind by means of one or more reflecting satellites or other objects in space;
- "earth station in motion" means earth stations installed on platforms in motion, land vehicle, aircraft, marine vessel, that communicate with satellite networks or systems in the fixed satellite services;
- "end-user" means the actual consumer who uses and consumes the products or services offered by the licensee;
- "fixed earth station" means an earth station that is installed and operating at a single specified or fixed location on the earth's surface in order to carry out the communications between specified fixed points using one or more satellites or as a feeder link in the mobile communication with satellites or for the broadcast of satellite signals;
- "fixed satellite service" means a radio communication service between earth stations at given positions, when one or more satellites are used; the given position may be a specified fixed point or any fixed point within specified areas; in some cases, this

- service includes satellite-to-satellite links, which may also be operated in the inter-satellite service; the fixedsatellite service may also include feeder links for other space radio communication services;
- "mobile earth station" is an earth station in the mobile satellite services intended to be used while in motion or during halts at unspecified points;
- "online media services" means online content services provided for the purpose of news and current affairs in a manner similar to, or in a manner that resembles services providers licensed under the Act;
- "public data centre" means a data centre that provide services for co-location or co-hosting of the customer's network, servers and storage equipment;
- "satellite filing" means a process to obtain satellite spectrum and associated orbital slot or orbits through the International Telecommunication Union for recording in the Master International Frequency Register for international recognition and protection;
- "satellite operator" means a person who owns, manages or operates a space station for provision of transmission capacity and satellite-based services including communication, broadcasting, navigation, Earth observation, and other related applications;
- "satellite landing right authorisation" means permission granted by the Authority to foreign satellite operator to

provide satellite capacity over the territory of the United Republic;

"submarine cable landing right authorisation" means permission by the Authority granted submarine cable operators to land the submarine cable for the provision of communications services over the territory of the United Republic; and "transportable earth station" is a fixed earth station that is transportable, operating at varying locations but remains in a fixed location during operation:

- (b) deleting the definitions of the terms "application services", "gross annual turnover" and "Very Small Aperture Terminal" and substituting for them the following:
 - "application services" means electronic communication services provided to the end-users;
 - "gross annual turnover" means the annual income earned by the licensee during the year under review with respect to the issued licences under the Act; and "Very Small Aperture Terminal" or in its
 - acronym "VSAT" is a small-sized earth station used to transmit or receive data, voice and video signals over a satellite communication network, excluding broadcast television;";
- (c) deleting the definition of the terms "Application Services (e-Commerce) Licence", "Class A Installation and Maintenance Licence", and "Class B Installation and Maintenance Licence."

Amendment of regulation 4

4. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 4 by deleting subregulation (3).

Addition of regulations 4A, 4B,4C,4D, and 4E

5. The principal Regulations are amended by adding immediately after regulation 4 the following:

"Satellite Services

- **4A.**-(1) A person who intends to provide electronic communication services using satellite shall apply for a national network facilities licence and install its gateway, earth station or hub, and point of presence within the United Republic.
- (2) A satellite operator who intends to provide capacity to existing licensees for the provision of communication services shall apply for satellite landing rights.

Application for satellite landing rights

- **4B.-**(1) An application for satellite landing rights referred to under regulation 4A(2) shall be made by the satellite notifying administration or foreign satellite operator owning the satellite network.
- (2) An application for satellite landing rights shall be accompanied by the following:
 - (a) a copy of the licence from home country in which the satellite is registered for launching; and
 - (b) evidence that the applicant has successfully undergone completed and coordination satellite process under the International Telecommunication Union frameworkor a proof of advanced

publication information filing with the International Telecommunication Union as well as other supporting documents indicating clearance from the International Telecommunication Union or the International Amateur Radio Union.

- (3) Where the foreign satellite operator operates several satellite networks, a separate authorisation is required for each satellite network or constellation of satellite networks.
- **(4)** Safety, amateur, meteorological, earth exploration, radio astronomy, radio navigation, and space research satellite shall be exempted from landing rights provided that they have undergone coordination and obtained approvals necessary from the affected administrations under the International Telecommunication Union satellite coordination framework.

Submarine Cable Services

- **4C**. A person who wishes to operate a submarine cable in the United Republic shall-
 - (a) apply for respective licence from the Authority; or
 - (b) apply for submarine cable landing rights and enter into contractual agreement with the

existing licensee with respective licences for operational and management of the submarine cable:

Provided that, in case of two or more licensees with indefeasible right of use in the submarine cable, landing rights will be issued on a first come basis and other licensees will be allowed to extend their pairs to the public data centre of their choice provided they have relevant licenses.

Call centre services

4D. A person shall not provide call centre services on behalf of another person unless he has obtained an application service licence from the Authority.

Public data centre services

- **4E.-(1)**A person shall not provide data centre services to the public unless he has obtained a network facility licence from the Authority.
- (2) A public data centre service provider shall be required to submit to the Authority on quarterly basis a list of all hosted customers.

Amendment of regulation 5

- **6.** The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 5(1)-
 - (a) in paragraph (b), by deleting a full stop appearing at the end of that paragraph and substituting for it a comma; and
 - (b) by deleting the closing phrase of paragraphs (a) and (b) and substituting for it the following:

"the Authority may after six months from the date of notification reject the application and inform the applicant in writing.".

Amendment or regulation 10

- 7. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 10-
 - (a) in subregulation (1), by deleting a comma appearing at the end of that regulation and substituting for it with a full colon;
 - (b) by adding immediately after subregulation (1) the following proviso:

"Provided that, the annual licence fee shall be due and paid annually on each date of the licence period cycle.".;

- (c) in subsection (2), by deleting the word "fifteen" and substituting for it the word "one";
- (d) by adding immediately after subregulation (6) the following:
 - "(7) Where the applicant has not responded for a period of six months for compliance which is required for his application to move into the next stage, the Authority may reject the application.

Amendment of regulation 21

- **8.** The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 21 by adding immediately after paragraph (d) the following paragraph:
 - "(e) a certified tax clearance certificate; and
 - (f) in case of application for the Cyber Security Service licence, a professional certificate from a recognised institution for the key staff of an entity."

Amendment of regulation 23

- **9.** The principal regulations are amended in regulation 23 by-
 - (a) deleting subregulation (5) and substituting for it the following:
 - "(5) Upon obtaining the Registrar of Companies' approval, the applicant shall submit to the Authority transfer documents including certified copies of share

certificates of its shareholders for the Authority to effect the changes.".

Amendment of regulation 24

- 10. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 24 by deleting subregulation (2) and substituting for it the following:
 - "(2) A licensee shall apply for consent for change of name to the Authority by filling an application form prescribed in the Fourth Schedule as customised in the Licensing Management System Portal of the Authority.".

Deletion and substitution of regulation 28

11. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 28 and substituting for it the following:

"Upgrading of licence

28.-(1) A licensee intending to upgrade its licence may apply to the Authority in writing by-

- (a) indicating the area which the service coverage needs to be extended; and
- (b) submitting a detailed business plan that substantiates the licensee's financial and technical capability to provide services in the proposed market segment.
- (2) Subject to subregulation (1), a content service (radio broadcasting) licence that requires spectrum, may apply for an upgrade upon an invitation issued by the Authority, as may be issued from time to time.
- (3) The Authority may approve the application submitted under subregulation (1), provided that the licensee is not in breach of any licence condition.".

Deletion of regulation 29

12. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 29.

Deletion and substitution of regulation 35

13. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 35 and substituting for it the following:

"Accounting requirements 35. -(1) A licensee shall-

- (a) submit to the Authority income statement within twenty one days after the end of each quarter; and
- (b) pay the computed royalty fee as prescribed in the First Schedule to these Regulations.
- (2) Within six months after the end of each financial year, the licensee shall-
 - (a) submit to the Authority annual financial reports audited by independent auditors; and
 - (b) pay the computed royalty thereof fee after the reconciliation between audited financial records and previously submitted quarterly income statements of licensee financial year as prescribed in the First Schedule to these Regulations.".

Amendment of regulation 36

14. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 36 by adding immediately after subregulation (4) the following:

"(5) A licensee shall notify the Authority the date of commencing provision of licensed services before commencing the provision of services."

Amendment of regulation

- **15.** The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 39 by-
 - (a) deleting subregulations (1) and substituting for it the following:
 - "(1) A licensee whose licence is about to expire and intends to continue with the provision of service, shall apply for renewal by filling out a renewal form as prescribed in the Third Schedule as customised in the Licensing Management Sytem Portal of the Authority and pay fees as set out in the First Schedule to these Regulations".
 - (b) deleting subregulation (6) and substituting for it the following:
 - "(6) On renewal a licensee shall pay a renewal fee and annual fee".

Deletion and substitution of regulation 41 **16.** The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 41 and substituting for it the following:

"Licensing procedure for installation and maintenance

- **41**. A licence for installation and maintenance shall be issued in the following classes:
 - (a) Class A for installation and maintenance electronic communication infrastructure and including equipment public exchange box, fibre, cabling, transmitters towers and infrastructure: related and

(b) Class B for installation and maintenance of end user electronic communication equipment and infrastructure including cell phones, transceiver equipment, and related small electronic communication appliances."

Amendment of regulation 42

- 17. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 42 by deleting subregulation (1) and substituting for it the following:
 - "(1) An applicant for Class A Installation and Maintenance Licence shall be required to-
 - (a) be a registered company or firm; and
 - (b) provide proof of qualified staff establishment and manning level.".

Deletion and substitution of First Schedule **18.** The principal Regulations are amended by deleting the First Schedule and substituting for it the following:
